There is a small nominated group of members who have worked alongside me for a considerably long time focused on looking at property in the light of the Mission of the Church. Part of this process has been to successfully sell the Old School Building, which has realised a certain sum of money for the Circuit, from which we can apply for a grant towards important projects. Identifying what needs to and should be done is still quite a challenge, and commissioning an Architect's feasibility Study has helped in many ways but has also underlined the enormous potential and cost. Now that we are armed with facts and figures it seems wise to meet with officers from the Methodist District to seek objective guidance and advice. Therefore I have arranged a visit from Mr Chris Linford (District Property Secretary) and Rev Jill Marsh (District Mission Enabler). There is an opportunity for all members of the congregation to meet them on Monday 18th June at 2pm in the Radford Room.
